THE ELIMINATOR POWER OF ELIMINATION

Catchphrase: "Hasta la vista, hazard! You won't be back!"

Power: Eliminates hazards completely, ensuring a safer world.

Weakness: Believes elimination is always possible, even when it's not.



SWITCHAROO POWER OF SUBSTITUTION

Catchphrase: "Swap it like it's hot!"

Power: Master of swapping out dangerous materials or processes for safer alternatives.

Weakness: Switcharoo's substituted materials or process might introduce new, unforeseen hazards.



CONTAINMENT COMMANDER POWER OF ISOLATION

Catchphrase: "To shield and protect—you shall not pass... this barrier!"

Power: Expert at isolating hazards and keeping them out of harm's way.

Weakness: May neglect other critical safety measures and create a false sense of safety.



CAPTAIN CONSTRUCT POWER OF ENGINEERING

Catchphrase: "Designing danger out of existence!"

Power: Redesigns the environment, equipment, or processes to remove a hazard or reduce exposure.

Weakness: Their controls can fail under specific conditions or require updates to remain effective.



ENFORCER: POWER OF ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROLS

Catchphrase: "Knowledge is power, and rules are your shield!"

Power: Sets and enforces rules, policies, and training to manage risks.

Weakness: Can overuse rules and create red tape. Relies on worker compliance.



GEAR GUARDIAN: POWER OF PPE

Catchphrase: "When all else fails, your personal protective gear prevails!"

Power: Equips people with protective gear as the final line of defence.

Weakness: Forgets they're only useful when all other controls fail.
